

Laurel All Church Rummage Sale

Laurels Lights and StitchNGo are happy to report that once again the Laurel congregation has responded to our call to help address Laurel's financial needs. We are rapidly gearing up for the all church rummage sale to be held on Friday March 8 and Saturday March 9. Over 70 individuals have volunteered to work before, during and after the sale. Church groups and individuals have graciously committed to supplying food and treats for the workers. Many of you are planning to donate items to the sale. Others are providing their support through prayer and expressions of gratitude for the volunteers. Our goal is to raise \$8,000.

The sale hours are 4:00 to 7:00 pm on Friday with a \$2 donation admission. Saturday hours are from 8:00 to 11:30 am with no admission fee; closed 11:30 to 12 to refresh the space; and then the half-price sale from 12:00 to 1:30 pm.

Anyone who has volunteered or still wishes to do so, should sign up for the days and times you are available, if you have not already done so. The sign up schedules are posted in the church Parlor. Specific tasks are assigned on the day(s) you come in. The tasks are varied and everyone's time and talents are appreciated.

Donated sale items can be dropped off in Fellowship Hall beginning Sunday morning March 3. Hours for donation drop off are Sunday March 3, 8:30 am to 1:00 pm; Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 9:30 am to 7:00 pm. Please bring items as early as possible in the week so we are ready by Friday. We accept all kinds of items including household (dishes/bowls/ cups, utensils, appliances), art work, books, décor, games & puzzles, crafts, lamps, sporting goods, pet supplies, linens, fabric, patterns, accessories, holiday decorations, children's clothes and toys, gardening, office supplies, electronics, entertainment media (records, tapes, CDs, DVDs), computer equipment, tools, hardware, camping equipment, bicycles, nick knacks, collectables, etc. However, we are not able to take large furniture, adult clothing, large appliances or TVs. Due to its success last year, unsold items will again be offered to Laurel members after services on Sunday March 10. The items will remain in Fellowship Hall after the sale ends Saturday and you may select any item(s) for a good will donation on Sunday. 2023 was a wonderful year for Stitch 'n Go!

Our group has grown, with several new ladies joining in our efforts. (Men are always welcome too!) New projects were undertaken, including port access shirts and sleeping mats made with plastic grocery bags woven on a

loom, while we continued to work on many other projects in support of Midwest Mission, schools, nursing homes, hospitals, and other organizations. Our 2023 end of the year totals are amazing:

- ◆ Total number of items donated: 10,291 That is an increase of 65% over last year!
- Organizations served: 52
- **♥** Types of projects worked on: **40**
- ◆ Average attendance at regularly scheduled work days: 41
- ◆ Total number of items donated since we began in 2017: 25,567

But our accomplishments go beyond what we made and donated. As we work together to serve others, each of us are richly blessed. Thank you to the Laurel congregation for helping us to serve thousands of people, both near and far.
